WE HONOR ELVIN "AL" LOVELADY U. S. Army & U. S. Air Force

Al was born on a farm in Vashti, Texas near Wichita Falls. Because his mother died when he was ten months old, he was raised by his grandparents in Oklahoma. He is an only child.

Elvin's wife Barbara of 53 years passed away on 1 October of this year, for which we extend our sincere condolences. They met in Wichita Falls and married a year later. They had five children including one adopted child. They have three remaining children, seven grandchildren and eleven great grandchildren.

According to AI, he has served in "five wars; Korean, Vietnam and three marriages."

He served in the Army National Guard out of high school in 1950 and was mobilized into the Army. He served three years in the Army and was stationed at Camp Polk, La., Japan and Korea as an infantryman. After being discharged, he worked for six months at roofing company before enlisting in the Air Force. He served nineteen years in the Air force as a security police officer. His Air Force career took him to Vance AFB, Oklahoma; Newfoundland; Shepherd AFB in Wichita Falls;

Clark AFB in the Philippines; and Vietnam. He retired at Bergstrom AFB, Texas in 1971. All has fifteen medals from the military.


