Know Your Neighbor

The following is from Lynn Gibson who is also our Garden Club President.

My name is Lynn Gibson and my husband Carey and I moved into the neighborhood five weeks before the "big storm" in August 2003. We had two dogs and we all huddled in the laundry room until the storm was over. During the next few days I saw several lost dog posters and thought about how I would feel if any of mine were missing and, I decided to see if I could help find the dogs. Several days later I actually found one of the dogs that was on a poster. He was playing with children in a neighbor's yard. I contacted the owner who e-mailed me a picture and I showed it to the people who were keeping the dog and then took the dog to return it to the little girl and her family who were missing their dog.

It was a moving, tearful, very happy reunion and, that's when I decided to become a volunteer for "Wee Rescue" in Austin.

Since I became a volunteer I have fostered 29 dogs. People always ask "how can you give them up when they get adopted?"

It's not always easy! Some stay for a few weeks and one foster was here eleven months. It's just such a good feeling placing a dog I have cared for with people who will love and care for it the rest of its life

The first foster I got was rescued from Town Lake Animal Shelter by our Wee Rescue volunteers and taken to our vet. The dog had apparently been hit by a car and also was heart worm positive. He had major surgery and was given meds for the heart worms. He came to me for five weeks of R&R and TLC and after the fifth week WE ADOPTED him!! After I realized we couldn't adopt them all I have placed all 29 of the dogs in wonderful loving forever homes!

By the way, I managed not to adopt any more dogs. Until the little guy who was with us eleven months decided he wanted to stay.

We just couldn't let him go!!
