Did you know that there are more than 700 houses within the North Oaks, Four Season and Hillside neighborhoods and yet only 124 houses were members of NEWCNA in 2018?

Did you know there are 12 volunteer executive committee and officer positions, with only 5 of them being filled in 2018? That's just 5 households contributing to our neighborhood association's volunteer officer needs out of more than 700 households! Surely we can all work together to find a way to do better than this as a neighborhood in 2019.

Did you know that NEWCNA official tax status is a 501(c)(7) which is a social/recreational club? Maybe the lack of recent volunteer interest is telling us that NEWCNA has over-reached it's boundaries in the past several years. The bylaws and responsibilities may need to be modified to make this social organization easier to manage.

Agenda for the January 30 meeting will include: Voting on new neighborhood entrance signs; Zoning Update on Peterson Property; Overview of all NEWCNA Executive Committee and officer vacant positions; Discussion of NEWCNA's future, including the unfortunate possibility of dissolving NEWCNA if new volunteers do not step forward by January 28, 2019.

All residents of North Oaks, Four Seasons, Hillside are encouraged to attend this meeting, however note only 2018 NEWCNA paid members will be able to vote on agenda items. That said, please know we want to hear your ideas and your voice even if you are not a 2018 paid member.

There are 2 zoning meetings January 15 & 31. Details are on the last page. Residents are encouraged to show support and attend.

We hope everyone has had a joyful holiday season and your new year is off to a good start. Please come out for this three meetings to help make NEWCNA the best neighborhood association it can possibly be by showing up, supporting, and volunteering in 2019!

- \***President** Leads the team to manage a 501C7, social organization, known as NEWCNA. Is the face of the neighborhood to all outside organizations: City of Austin, ZAP, APD, Developers, etc.
- \*Vice President Each subdivision has their own VP that helps coordinate socials, YOM, distribute newsletters to block captains.
- \*Recording Secretary Charge of meeting minutes, correspondence, membership.
- \***Treasurer** Collects, tracks membership dues, tracks budget, bank account, credit card processing receipts, NEWCNA mailbox.
- \*Media Secretary Manages Facebook and NEWNCA website. Creates quarterly newsletter, coordinates with advertisers, takes to printer, and co-bundles for distribution.
- \*Zoning/Code/Compliance Chair Along with the President reaches out for updates of the Peterson Track to the City, APD, developers for changes. Emails all NEWCNA current members with updates.
- \*Social/Event Chair Leads team to plan, advertising, get donations, coordinate setup and clean up for Spring and Fall Picnics, and Annual Garage Sale.
- \*Beautification Chair Team meets periodically to collect trash around neighborhood entrances, mows around the stop signs at neighborhood entrances.

**Block Captains** Deliver newsletters to specified addresses quarterly, and periodically for other unplanned announcements. We can't go completely digital as not everyone has email, nor participates in social media.

**Yard of the Month** April thru September, and December. Each sub-division needs a 3 person team to choose the yard to receive the monthly recognition.


## City of Austin Council Monthly Meeting January 31, 2019 at 10am
